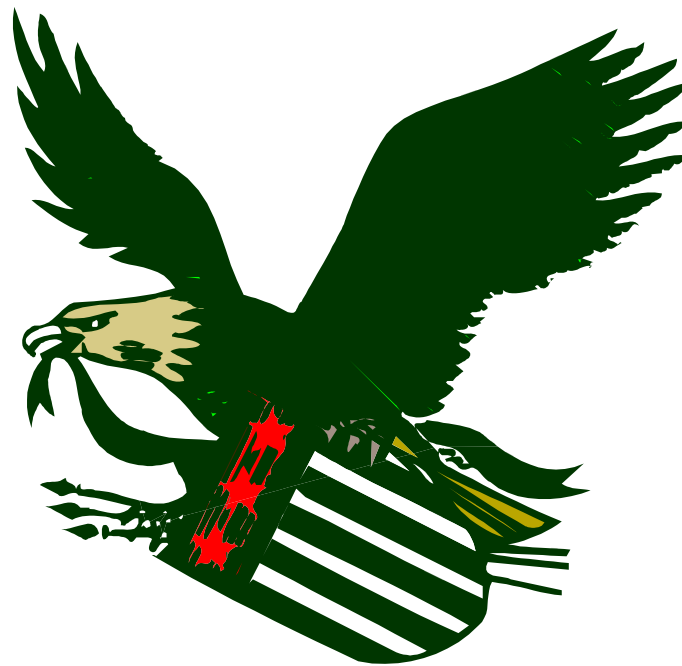

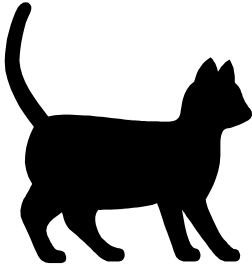

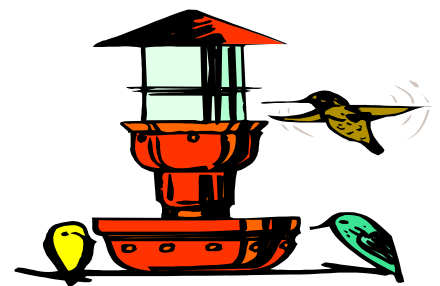
*Soon, the back yard was like it used to be...quiet, serene and no one demanding their rights to a free meal.*

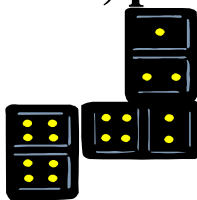
